Steering Committee:

The LLHS DEI Committee is comprised of a volunteer group of parents, teachers, and students. The leadership of the committee is held by a steering committee that is appointed by the PTSA for a term of 1 year. This will be a standing committee of the PTSA.

The Steering Committee is responsible for identifying and setting the direction of the DEI Committee. Its members act as ambassadors for the DEI work conducted on the LLHS Campus, represent the LLHS DEI Committee at AUHSD meetings with other groups, including, but not limited to: the AUHSD DEI Committee, the Curriculum Committee, and other committees as they evolve.

The Steering Committee will create subcommittees as needed to align and shepherd different aspects of DEI work as they arise. Subcommittees will be identified through parent, student, and teacher surveys.

From time to time, the Steering Committee may work with the PTSA to fundraise for specific programs, community education events, or in concert with other student campus groups who are furthering the educational and inclusion goals of the LLHS DEI Committee.
